Leadership Scholarship

Leadership Scholarships are available to students who have demonstrated strong leadership qualities and wish to experience leadership opportunities through the Student Leadership program offered at Greenvale Secondary College. The successful applicant will display personal maturity, confidence, an outstanding work ethic and behaviour. They must be encouraging and supportive of fellow students and have the ability to inspire or motivate.

Sporting Scholarship

Sporting Scholarships are available to promising young athletes who demonstrate the qualities of sportsmanship both on and off the field; additionally, these students exhibit skills of teamwork. Supporting documentation and/or references will be required as evidence of level of sporting achievement. Potential recipients must also be able to demonstrate our College Values or Excellence, Teamwork, Leadership and Respect.

Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship

Visual and Performing Arts scholarships are available to students who demonstrate exceptional talent in one or more of the fields of music, drama, dance, and visual art (such as painting, drawing, or sculpting).
